

## HOW ENP TEAMS AND SELECTED STUDENTS INTERACT?

Congratulations you've been selected by the Chilean committee of experts.

### STEP 1:

You have to identify and rank **by order of preference** three internship proposals from the offers listed on the [website](#). **NB:** The order of preference is important, because a team can only host one student for a period of 6 months.

### STEP 2:

Once your choice is made, you have to send to ENP ([enp@paris-neuroscience.com](mailto:enp@paris-neuroscience.com)) and NOT to the ENP teams:

- The [internship form](#) completed with the list of three internship proposals;
- Your motivation for each internship chosen;
- Your CV;
- A copy of your passport;
- Contact information ((phone/skype) );
- Contact details of a referee.

### STEP 3:

ENP will check these information and forward them to the first ranked ENP team. If the first ranked ENP team chosen has already selected a student, the ENP will inform you as soon as possible.

### STEP 4:

ENP teams can contact you for a phone interview (not compulsory).

### STEP 5:

The ENP team informs ENP about his/her final decision. If the first ranked ENP team cannot host the student, the ENP forwards the internship form and the required documents to the second ranked team, etc.

ENP informs you about ENP team's final decision and the conditions of ENP support.

### STEP 6:

Once accepted by an ENP team, you have to send to ENP an acceptance letter in order to confirm your internship and read the document entitled "Hosting process & ENP Support". Welcome to Paris!

### STEP 7:

At the end of your internship, you are expected to write and send a short report to ENP on the [appropriate form](#).
