Scientific Advisory Board

Chair of excellence

The ENP Steering Committee and Board of Trustees validated the application for "chair of excellence" of C. Wyart, currently post-doc at UC Berkeley under the supervision of Ehud Y. Isacoff. She works on manipulation and recording of neuronal activity *in vivo* using optogenetics in the zebrafish. C. Wyart will join the ICM (*Institut du Cerveau et de la Moëlle*) in July.

On the 296 applications, four applicants coming from China, India, Russia, & USA, were selected to join the PhD Program and will arrive in Paris in September 2010.

A new European PhD Program in Neurosciences

On behalf of the *Ecole Doctorale 3C* and the ENP, a meeting to explore the possibility of an European PhD Program in Neurosciences was organized at the Institut du Fer à Moulin on June, 24th 2010. This project involves several Neuroscience programs: SISSA (Trieste, Italy), Universidad Autonoma de Madrid (Spain), the Champalimaud Neuroscience Program (Lisbon, Portugal), the Edinburgh University (United Kingdom), the Semmelweis University (Budapest, Hungary), the Pierre & Marie Curie University and ENP.
