

Call for Applications ENP program for sabbaticals

The Paris School of Neuroscience supports **sabbatical stays (1-12 months)** of the best researchers and academics in its affiliated laboratories.

The applicants can be **foreigners or French expatriates**. The researchers, on sabbatical leave from academic positions, will have to be **nominated by a group leader affiliated to ENP**.

The applicants are expected to **give three lectures** at Institutes belonging to the ENP that are different from the host laboratory*. These lectures will be organized by the hosting laboratory in coordination with ENP staff.

Applications must include:

- A CV and a list of recent publications (max. 10) of the applicant.
- A description of the scientific project (up to one page) the period of stay.
- Starting date expected.
- A letter of agreement from the director of the host laboratory.
- A short description by the applicant and the director of the host laboratory of how the research program will be accomplished and of the expected mutual benefit of the collaboration (up to one page).
- A financial plan indicating the planned arrangements of the applicant with her/his home institution (including expected salary and other sources of revenue) during the sabbatical stay, and the possible sources of support for travel, housing and research.

No fixed deadline

The ENP will give a **first reply on the admissibility of the application within a month after reception of the application**. The applications are reviewed by ENP's Steering Committee which takes the funding decisions after external expertise if necessary. The final answer will be given in agreement with the concerned institutions.

The ENP can provide up to half of the total salary during the sabbatical period and covers a round-trip ticket Paris/home country.

The host laboratory is in charge of all the administrative entrance formalities (visa, *residence permit*, etc.) and research support.

The applications have to be exclusively submitted by the host ENP team leader by email at enp@paris-neuroscience.com

*Including, if possible depending on the period of the stay, one lecture at the ENP's Annual Symposium
