

Call for proposals Chairs of excellence Junior

This call aims to facilitate the mobility promising scientists at an early stage of their career coming from a foreign country or another region of France, within ENP's research priorities.

A particular attention is given to the interdisciplinary or highly innovative projects. The support is 350 k€ maximum and can be used for salaries, running costs, equipment, etc... The selection is based on the scientific quality of the applicants and the interest of their coming for neuroscience in Île-de-France.

Application must include

- A short letter from the head of the host institution, justifying:
 - the provisional, human resources allocated to the applicant.
 - the space and if applicable, equipment and human resources allocated.
 - the applicant added value for host laboratory and for the ENP.
 - secured or pending support.
- A CV of the applicant, a list of his/her publications and all other evidence supporting his/her scientific excellence.
- A research project.
- A short description of the planned research group (staff, provisional budget, necessary equipment, etc.)

What is expected from "Chairs of Excellence Junior"

- Participation in the organisation and running of the PhD program (applications, scoring, interviews of the candidates, advice to students...)
- Involvement in ENP events (organisation, oral presentations of research work in progress).
- Facilitating the international social network, spread information about ENP...

No fixed deadline.

The host laboratory is in charge of all the administrative entrance formalities (visa, residence permit, etc.) and research support.

The ENP will give a first reply on the possibility of support within two month after reception of the application. Applications are reviewed by ENP's Steering Committee which takes the funding decisions after external expertise if necessary. The final agreement will be given after validation with the Board of Trustees.
